General Rules

First time participation is limited to non-profit organizations.

Previous participants are usually accepted automatically if they have followed the State of Indiana and Tippecanoe County Board of Health rules and regulations, worked cooperatively within Feast guidelines, and worn suitable period clothing.

Application is non-transferable and must be returned before April 24, 2024 to be considered.

To protect the public, your liability as well as the liability of the Tippecanoe County Historical Association and the Feast of the Hunters' Moon Committee, you are required to send a representative(s) to the annual Food Vendor Meeting. This meeting will be **6:00 p.m., Thursday, April 24, 2024** at the **Tippecanoe Battlefield Museum, 200 Battle Ground Avenue, Battle Ground, IN 47920**. The Tippecanoe County Board of Health will be covering their concerns from last year as well as any changes they are requiring for this year. You will receive paperwork from TCHA during the meeting.

All food booth participants are not automatically exempt from the collection of sales tax by reason of its participation in the Feast and the participating food vendor should contact its own accountant or attorney to determine whether it has any obligation to collect and remit sales tax to the State of Indiana. All vendors must be registered with the Indiana Department of Revenue in order to sell on the festival grounds, including out-of-state residents. If you do not have an Indiana Retail Sales Tax Number, contact the Indiana Department of Revenue, 100 Executive Drive, Lafayette, IN 47905, for an application. Phone (765) 448-6626.

I/we understand my organization must send a representative to the Food Vendor Meeting. I/we also understand that failure to have a representative at the Food Vendor Meeting may prohibit our organization from operating a food booth at the Feast.

I, on behalf of my organization members and participants, agree the Tippecanoe County Historical Association and the Feast of the Hunters' Moon Committee are not liable for loss, damage, or injury to ourselves or our property during the course of the Feast of the Hunters' Moon, including setup and teardown, and further will hold harmless TCHA and the Feast of the Hunters' Moon Committee for all losses resulting from our acts or omissions or those of any minor children. We agree we will not use the phrases "Fort Ouiatenon" or "Feast of the Hunters' Moon", illustrations of the Ouiatenon blockhouse, or any Feast of the Hunters' Moon logos on any items to be sold at the Feast of the Hunters' Moon.
