CityBus to Provide Bus Service to Feast of the Hunters' Moon

Lafayette, IN: CityBus will provide supplemental transportation services for the 2024 Feast of the Hunters' Moon on Saturday, October 5th and Sunday, October 6th.

Attendees can ride to the event from the Discovery Park parking lot. Bus service will begin at 8:30 am on both days of the event and will end at 6:00 pm on Saturday and 5:00 pm on Sunday.

"The Feast of the Hunters' Moon brings one of the largest crowds of any community gathering to our area," said Bryan D. Smith, Chief Executive Officer. "The Feast draws tens of thousands of people that come to learn about and celebrate the rich historical culture of our community."

Attendees looking to take advantage of the bus transportation will pay regular CityBus fare. \$2 Day passes, which are good for an unlimited number of rides for the service day, will be available for credit and debit card purchase at the Discovery Park parking lot pick up location. Cash will NOT be accepted for fare-payment for bus transportation to the event.

All CityBus fare-cards will be honored as valid fare for the event. Ivy Tech students, faculty, and staff can ride free by presenting a valid identification card. Children, including K-12, ride free. CityBus will provide ACCESS paratransit services to the event for certified riders. To assist with transportation planning, please schedule your trip as far in advance as possible.

Those looking to purchase a \$2 Day Pass prior to the event may do so at the CityBus Center at 316 N 3rd St in Lafayette (open Monday – Friday 7 am to 8:45 pm and Saturday – Sunday 10 am to 5:45 pm) or at the CityBus administrative office at 1250 Canal Road in Lafayette (open Monday – Friday 8 am to 4:30 pm).

Mobile tickets, including \$2 Day Pass or Feast of the Hunters' Moon \$2 Day Pass, can be purchased through the Token Transit app, which can be downloaded for free from the Google Play or Apple App Stores.

CityBus, the operating name for the Greater Lafayette Public Transportation Corporation, is a municipal corporation established in 1971. As a division of local government, CityBus is led by a Board of Directors, whose members are appointed by the mayors and city councils of Lafayette and West Lafayette. CityBus provides approximately 4.4 million rides annually for passengers in the Greater Lafayette area, including ADA paratransit services for people with differing abilities.
